The International Baccalaureate Organization aims to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.

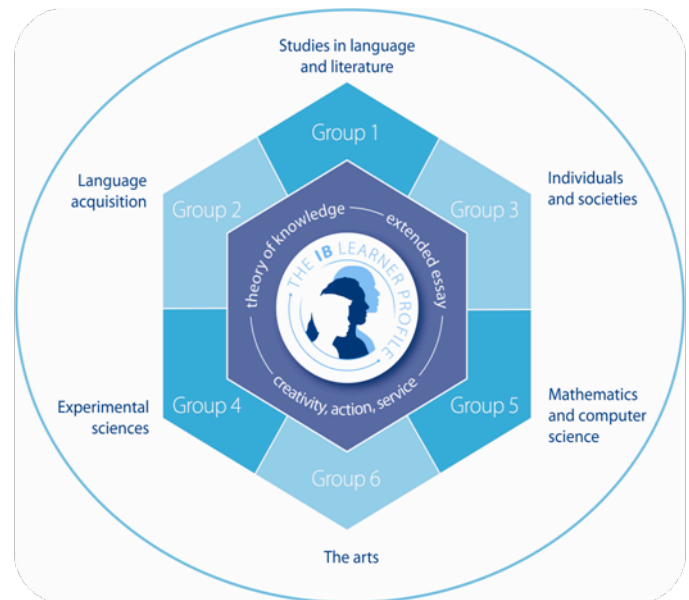

IB Diploma

The IB Diploma requires students to study 3 academic subjects at Higher level and 3 at Standard level in addition to the 3 mandatory core components; Theory of Knowledge (TOK), Extended Essay and Creativity, Action and Service (CAS).

The two year Diploma program provides students with a breadth and depth of academic study which prepares them for the demands of university with the additional learning opportunities of:

Theory of Knowledge – critical thinking
Extended Essay – research and academic writing
CAS – activities beyond the classroom or study room involving creativity, action and service.



Non-diploma access

All ISB students have access to IB classes and the IB diploma. Students are encouraged to include a degree of challenge in their course choices as part of their preparation for college.

ISB students in IB classes are expected to take the final IB examinations. In general, non-diploma students take between 1 and 6 IB examinations and receive an official IBO transcript of their scores.
