As members of the ISA, parents at ISB are in a unique position to play an important part in determining the strategic direction of the school. With our children's education being one of the most important investments we'll ever make, I would like to make the most of the opportunity of being re-elected a Board member to ensure that our children receive one of the best educations in the world.

Serving on the Board for the past six years as Treasurer and Chairman has been immensely fulfilling, especially since ISB has continued to improve in many areas of the school.

One of the areas where I want to continue serving the Board is in maintaining the integrity of the school and safeguarding ISA's governance structure under the Private School Act 2550. I believe we have made the necessary adjustments to comply with the new law, although we need to ensure that there is no, or limited effect, on ISA's finances and governance structure as we seek to make ISB compliant.

I strongly support the idea of "continuous improvement". It enables ISB to take incremental steps forward in realizing its vision for learning. Implementation of the Learning Indicators has given the school and the BOT an important tool in measuring this progress. As a Board member I would like to keep on emphasizing the importance of quantifying progress, benchmarking it against set targets and using the indicators as a tool to identify areas of improvement.

Under the Head of School's leadership, I see that in 10 years time, the ISB 2020 vision will have resulted in more "voice and choice", and we will continue to make improvements that affect learning. ISB will have solidified its position and reputation as one of the best international schools in the world. Perceived weaknesses will have been strengthened and best practices continue to be put into place to guarantee that the gap between students' learning potential and what they actually learn will have become so much smaller.

In this vision we mustn't forget the importance ISB plays in the social life of our children. Countless hours are spent at school during afternoon activities, various other school and community events or just "hanging". Children interact with teachers, parents and each other at various levels. Going to school is fun (which looking at some of our own school experiences might be a surprising notion) and I support the Board's focus in this area. We should continue to provide excellent facilities and support these extra-curricular activities to a larger degree. Balancing the advantages of the current open campus with the potential security risks, will be one of the tasks the Board faces in the short term.

In my opinion the role of the Board of Trustees in the governance of ISB is very straight forward. The BOT should set the overall direction of the school, with the school's vision and mission

foremost in mind. This direction needs to be translated into measurable goals and targets which are jointly determined and agreed upon with the Head of School. Finally the BOT has the responsibility to monitor the progress and evaluate if the targets have been achieved within the set time-frame.

In practice this will involve a close and constructive relationship between the BOT and school administration. Based on their experience and expertise, the administration will enjoy significant trust and autonomy in their work.

In light of the above, I hope to continue to bring to the Board a result-driven perspective and a positive and collaborative attitude.

I've had the good fortune of being an ISB parent for the past fifteen years, and hope to be one for the remaining three years it will take for my youngest daughter Carina to graduate. My commitment to ISB is for the long term.
