Update COVID-19 Vaccinations for Community

Dear ISB Community,

As many of us settle in to enjoy the summer break, our Health Coordinator and his team continue to help procure vaccines for our community. We understand the importance of doing our part to help Thailand in the effort to return to a much more open, healthy environment and to reopen our campus in the fall.

In late May, we sent a communication and survey to our community asking who would be interested in receiving the Sinopharm vaccine should we be approved to receive them. We are pleased that recently we have been awarded a limited quota for our ISB community.

We have established priorities to guide our decision making in allocating these vaccines and to help us create the safest on campus environment possible.

We will be prioritizing students over 18 years old, staff and others that work closely with students. Any remaining vaccines will be distributed to our community on a first come, first served basis (according to the timestamp on the Sinopharm survey).

Currently we are contacting those who have expressed interest in the Sinopharm vaccine in phases, and to check if they are still interested in this option as in the meantime many may already have been vaccinated or have a scheduled appointment.

In order to provide the widest access to vaccines for our community, **it is essential that anyone who already has arranged for a vaccine through any agency or programme keep that appointment and not sign up for this option.**

Vaccination efforts are one, very important part of a "return to normal". Our team will continue to do its best in finding different avenues for getting more people access to vaccinations. Therefore, if based on our first-come first-serve policy you do
